



£1.7m Superbowl UK and family entertainment centre to launch in Barnsley and bring 30 jobs to the town

Barnsley's ambitious regeneration is about to get bowled over as ten-pin bowling operator Superbowl UK have formally signed up for an 18,000sq ft. unit at The Glass Works. More than £1.8m is being invested into the Family Entertainment complex before launching in 2020.

Superbowl UK, an independent family run business, currently has 6 venues around the UK. The new Barnsley venue will boast 12 state of the art bowling lanes, Crazy Club Soft Play centre, stylish lounge bar and food diner, as well as a modern amusement arcade arena.

It is estimated 30 jobs will be created once Superbowl UK Barnsley is open and the company has committed to using local tradesmen through the fit-out process. The centre is due to be fitted out over an intense 16-week development.

Commenting on Superbowl UK's decision to join the redevelopment, company director Kate Quaintance-Blackford said, *"We are really excited to be launching a brand-new centre in Barnsley. The Glass Works presents us with the opportunity to showcase our stylish and unique offerings, whilst delivering a high quality, customer focused service at competitive prices."*
